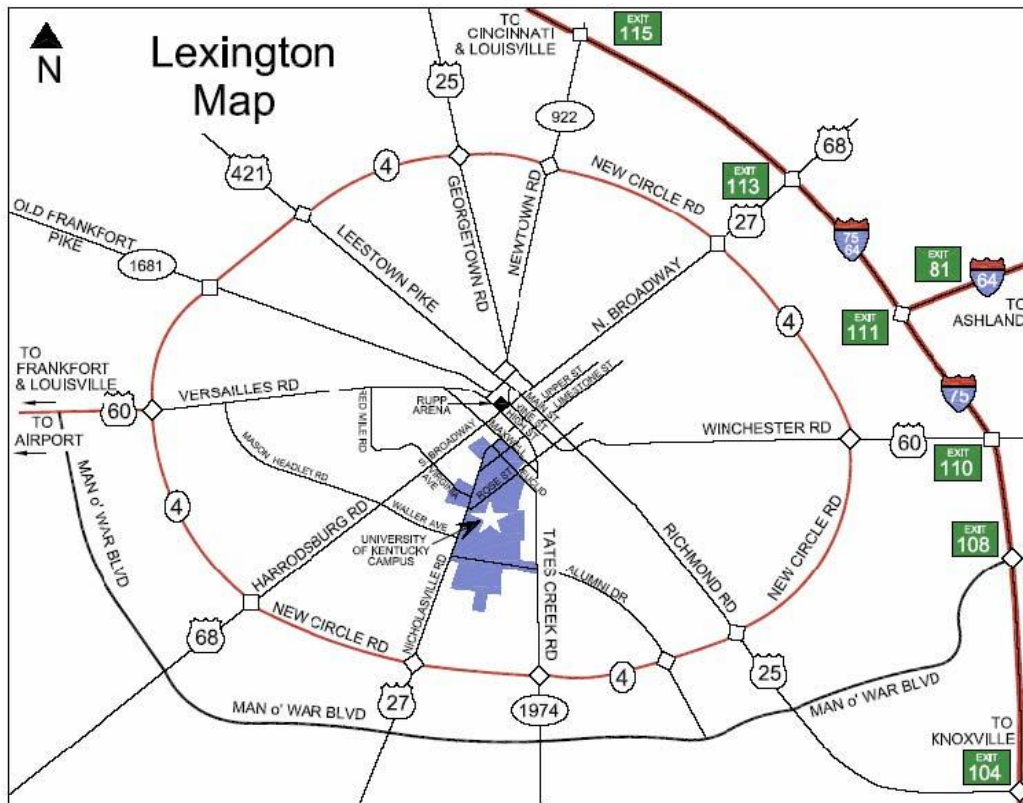

DIRECTIONS



FROM WEST VIA I-64 OR FROM NORTH I-75

Follow I-64 east or south to exit 115.

Turn right (south) off exit ramp onto Newtown Pike (route 922).

Follow Newtown Pike about 3 ½ miles and turn left onto Main Street.

Follow Main Street (will curve into Vine Street) about 1/3 mile and turn right onto Upper Street. Turn left at second stoplight onto Maxwell Street.

Turn right at second stoplight onto Martin Luther King Blvd.

At the next stoplight the University of Kentucky Student Center will be in front of you. Turn left.

Immediately to your right is the Student Center and, beyond it, the Student Center Parking lot. Park there.

FROM EAST VIA I-64 OR SOUTH VIA I-75

Follow I-64 west or I-75 north to exit 113.

Turn right off exit ramp onto North Broadway (US 68).

Follow through downtown for 3 ½ miles.

One block past the Hyatt Regency Hotel, turn left at the stoplight onto Maxwell Street.

Turn right at the fourth stoplight onto Martin Luther King Blvd.

At the next stoplight the University of Kentucky Student Center will be in front of you. Turn left.

Immediately to your right is the Student Center and, beyond it, the Student Center Parking lot. Park there.

FROM SOUTH VIA I-65

Follow I-65 north to Elizabethtown, then follow the Blue Grass Parkway to Lexington.

Turn right off the ramp onto Route 60 (Versailles Road).

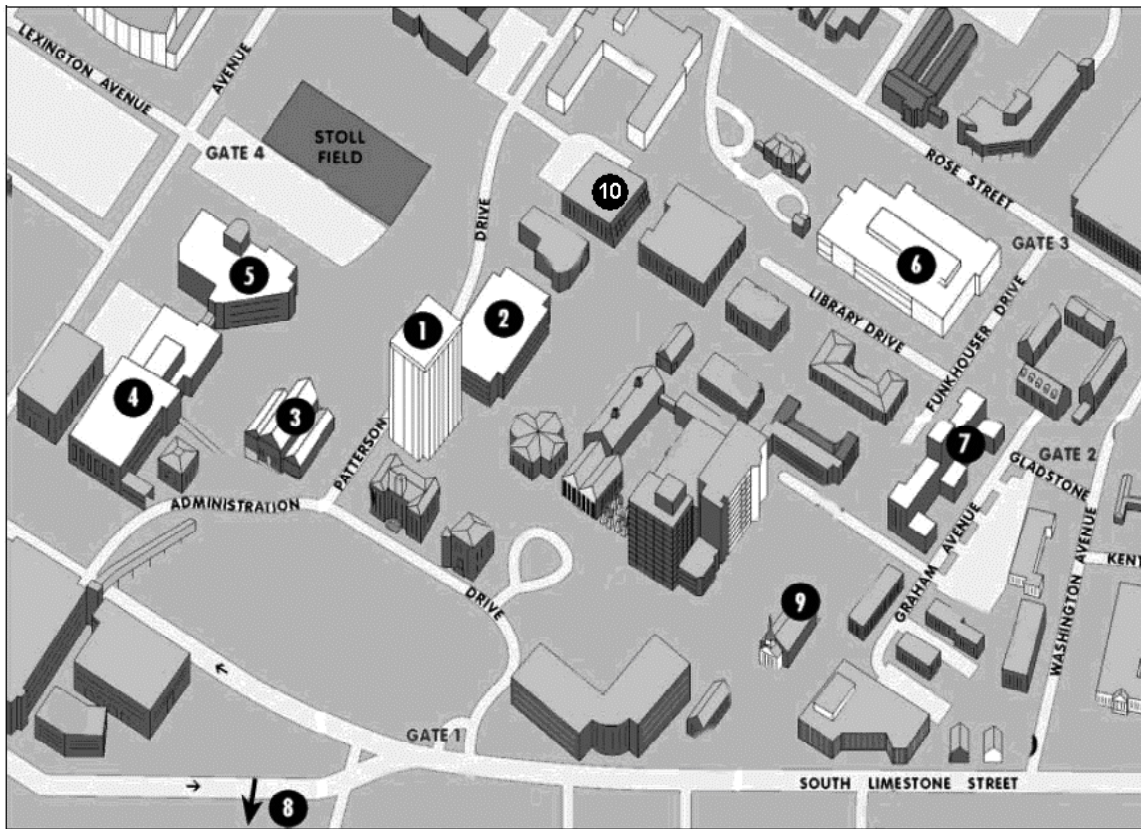
Follow it into Lexington until it becomes a one-way street, West Maxwell.

At the fifth stoplight on Maxwell, turn right onto Martin Luther King Blvd.

At the next stoplight the University of Kentucky Student Center will be in front of you. Turn left.

Immediately to your right is the Student Center and, beyond it, the Student Center Parking lot. Park there.
