Want to learn more about **Linguafolio**? Linguafolio Workshops will be held May 20th and June 10th (repeat of May 20th session). Linguafolio is a self-assessment tool developed in part by Jacque van Houten of the Kentucky Department of Education and based upon the European Language Passport. Come hear from teachers currently using the Linguafolio and find out how it can help your students understand and articulate their level of language proficiency. Open to all languages.

Want to learn more about **STAMP**? STAMP Workshops will be held June 3rd and June 11th (repeat of June 3rd session). STAMP is an on-line summative assessment developed by the Center for Applied Second Language Studies at the University of Oregon. Based on the ACTFL proficiency guidelines and the national standards, STAMP testing is currently being piloted in Kentucky, Oregon, New Jersey and other states. Open to all languages.
