LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
2009 Nomination Form

Award Description

The Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes an individual of the world language teaching profession who has demonstrated long-term achievement and service to KWLA and to the profession – locally, statewide, regionally, and/or nationally.

Award Criteria

1. Eligibility: (Must be a current KWLA member in good standing with a minimum of 20 years in the teaching profession. A history of service to KWLA is required.
2. Review of candidate's professional achievements and activities.
3. Evidence of continued professional growth.
4. Excellence in teaching and/or administration.
5. Service to the world language teaching profession locally, regionally, and/or nationally.
6. Service to the Kentucky World Language Association (formerly the Kentucky Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages.)

Award Procedure

1. Nominations can be made by an administrator or a colleague.
2. Submit the following to the KWLA Awards Committee:
 - a) The Award Nomination Form
 - b) A letter of endorsement from a professional colleague
 - c) A letter of endorsement from a supervisor/administrator

- d) A letter of endorsement from a current or former student or parent
 - e) A current Curriculum Vitae which includes: Educational background; Teaching experience; Recent travel related to teaching; Service to KWLA; Service to the world language profession as a whole; Membership in other professional organizations; Workshops given, papers presented, articles published; Awards and honors received
3. Deadline for submission of all nomination packets is **Wednesday, August 26, 2009.**
 4. Complete nomination packets are to be submitted electronically to sharon.mattingly@barren.kyschools.us.
 5. Winners will be notified by Friday, September 4, 2009.
 6. Awards will be presented at the 2009 Fall Conference on September 19, 2009 in Lexington, Kentucky.
 7. Conference Registration is the responsibility of the individual; however, award recipients will receive two complementary tickets to the Awards Luncheon. Additional luncheon tickets will be available for purchase.
 8. At the discretion of the KWLA Awards Committee and in consultation with the Executive Board an award may not be presented during a given year.

All documentation must be complete for the nomination to be valid. Nomination Deadline: August 26, 2009!

Awards will be presented at the 2009 KWLA Fall Conference, September 19, 2009, in Lexington, Kentucky.
