OUTSTANDING TEACHER AWARD
2010 Nomination Form (Postsecondary)

Award Description

The Outstanding Teacher Award recognizes individuals of the world language teaching profession who have demonstrated long-term achievement and service to the profession.

Award Criteria

1. Eligibility (Current KWLA members in good standing with a minimum of three consecutive years of membership and a minimum of ten years' experience as a world language educator are eligible. Candidates must be full-time language teachers who spend at least half of their time in direct teaching, and who expect to continue teaching for at least two more years.)
2. A record of excellence in teaching
3. Professional achievements and activities
4. Evidence of continued professional growth
5. Service to the world language teaching profession

Nomination Packet

Nominations can be made by a school administrator or a colleague. The following must be submitted to the KWLA Awards Committee:

1. The Award Nomination Form
2. A letter of endorsement from a professional colleague
3. A letter of endorsement from a supervisor/administrator
4. A letter of endorsement from a current or former student

5. A current Curriculum Vitae of not more than five pages which includes: Educational background; Teaching experience; Recent travel related to teaching; Service to the world language profession as a whole; Membership in other professional organizations; Workshops given, papers presented, articles published; Awards and honors received
6. A five-hundred word first-person statement on the value of learning language and culture from the nominee
7. The Commitment Form

Award Procedure

1. Deadline for submission of all nomination packets is **Friday, August 20, 2010**.
2. Complete nomination packets are to be submitted electronically to sharon.mattingly@barren.kyschools.us.
3. Winners will be notified by Friday, September 3, 2010.
4. Awards will be presented at the KWLA Fall Conference on September 18, 2010 in Lexington, Kentucky.
5. Conference Registration is the responsibility of the individual; however, award recipients will receive two complementary tickets to the Awards Luncheon. Additional luncheon tickets will be available for purchase.
6. The KWLA Awards Committee in consultation with the Executive Board may elect not to present an award for a given year.

All documentation must be complete for the nomination to be valid. Nomination Deadline: August 20, 2010!

Awards will be presented at the KWLA Fall Conference, September 18, 2010, in Lexington, Kentucky.
